Dear Iowa Senators,

The Iowa Cultural Coalition works in partnership with, and on behalf of, the more than 43,000 Iowans who are part of the creative sector. This growing and dynamic industry is part of the fabric of every Iowa community--from creative businesses dotting our rural Main Streets, to our arts, history and science centers and museums that contribute so much to our quality of life and attract visitors and talent to our state. The ICC exists to raise awareness with local, state and federal elected officials around the necessity of investing in this industry, in part through the important work and grant funding programs offered by the Iowa Department of Cultural Affairs and the Iowa Arts Council. Their work on behalf of our cities and rural communities is also an important piece of growing our state's population and economy.

#### Did You Know

- Iowa's Arts & Culture sector contributes 43,000 jobs to Iowa's economy and represents 2.1% of the state's GDP totaling \$4.1 billion dollars. If Iowa's Arts & Culture Sector were a single employer it would rank 2nd and on par with Iowa's largest employers.<sup>1</sup>
- Rural counties with strong arts and cultural attractions welcome more visitors, have higher business innovation scores, and attract more workers and population growth.<sup>2</sup>

With 67% of Iowa counties still losing population, strong support for the creative sector is vital in ensuring that ALL of Iowa grows. To that end, **we support the Iowa Arts Council's request this year for \$3.19 million in funding – or \$1.00 for every Iowan.** Funding at this level will make Iowa competitive with our surrounding states that spend far more than Iowa on the arts and are competing better for jobs and workers.

Take a look at this report. Note how many dollars flowed to your district from Iowa Arts Council grants, and know that every \$1.00 in grant funding leverages another \$9 in public and private funds. An investment in the creative sector is an investment in Iowa. Your support of the Iowa Arts Council will be an economic driver for your district and our state.

Thank you for all you do for history, culture, film, art and the creative economy.

# OVERVIEW

For a second year, the Iowa Cultural Coalition has assembled this report to illustrate all the public investment in the arts, culture, film, history and community development that flowed through the Iowa Department of Cultural Affairs (IDCA), a state agency. The report shows the public investment made in every Iowa Senate and House district (*prior to redistricting*) for the State of Iowa's fiscal year 2022 (FY 2022), beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022.

This report summarizes investment from state, regional and federal sources, including appropriations from the Iowa Legislature and funding directed by Congress and several federal agencies to the IDCA through state partnership agreements and competitive federal awards. This includes standing partnerships with the National Endowment for the Arts (NEA), the National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) and Arts Midwest, along with one-time funding through the Paul Bruhn Historic Revitalization Grant Program, administered by the National Parks Service.

This report reflects numerous funding lines and grant programs administered by the IDCA, which includes the State Historical Society of Iowa and its' Library, Archives and Museums, as well as Historic Sites and the State Historic Preservation Office; the Iowa Arts Council; the interim Iowa Humanities Council; and Produce Iowa, State Office of Film and Media.

The Iowa Cultural Coalition supports the goal of fostering economic and population growth in Iowa's urban and rural communities. Economic growth requires jobs, employers, and employees to choose Iowa as their home. Iowa can count on the creative sector to make Iowa a welcoming state, and one that attracts and retains people in communities.

The Iowa Cultural Coalition's three points of advocacy, which are aligned with the State of Iowa's priorities, state that arts and culture:

- Attract and retain talent
- Promote economic development
- Build strong communities

This year we support the Iowa Arts Council's budget request of \$1.00 per Iowan, or \$3.19 million to support their Create in Iowa initiative. With \$1.00 per Iowan, the IAC will use the creative sector to make Iowa competitive with our surrounding states, which invest much more on the arts per capita. It will also pump dollars into rural counties; 67% of Iowa counties have lost population since the last census. By focusing on the creative economy now, Iowa can ensure its competitiveness with its neighboring and other fast-growing states.

Supporting the creative sector is an investment in Iowa's future. Read on to learn more.
