

Dear Iowa Senators,

This report details all of the arts and culture funding distributed through grants from the Iowa Arts Council to your district, and every other district across the state, in 2023.

Last year the Legislature increased the Iowa Arts Council's base budget for the first time in over 10 years, which was a very welcome development. Yet, Iowa has a long way to go to keep up with arts and culture funding in our surrounding neighbor and peer states, which outspend Iowa per capita by three or four times, as shown on the next page. Iowa is falling behind. In the aggregate, arts and culture is a vibrant industry worthy of strong state support and vital to the state's success. For comparison, arts and culture production ranks near transportation and ahead of utilities and educational services in terms of value added to Iowa's economy. All of these industries are considered vital to our state's economy.

Iowa's nonprofit arts and cultural organizations are an especially good example of a strong return on the state's investment. According to the new Arts and Economic Prosperity 6 report from Americans for the Arts, the nonprofit arts and culture industry produced \$705 million in economic activity and supported 12,411 jobs in Iowa. Greater state support will drive more spending, employment, and economic development.

Some may argue that arts and culture should simply seek greater local corporate or philanthropic support. However, recent data also shows major shifts and increasing competition for private funding. Sadly, the communities that are hardest hit by declining investment in arts and culture don't have the local corporate support or an economic base to fund these projects themselves.

The Iowa Economic Development Authority, now the home to the Iowa Arts Council, and chambers of commerce across the state know that vibrant arts and culture programs attract and retain talent, keep young people in Iowa for work in a range of creative industries, and strengthen economic development across sectors. Arts and culture make our towns and cities more welcoming; they also make great business sense.

Many, many grants scored as worthy of funding are left unfunded by the Iowa Arts Council every year. We know that \$1.00 in grant funding returns nine additional dollars to a community. The Iowa Cultural Coalition continues to advocate for an annual budget for the Iowa Arts Council of \$3.19 million, or \$1.00 per Iowan for the arts (an increase from the current \$.32 per Iowan). Just think what your district could do with three times as much grant funding.

Iowa, the home of Grant Wood, Meredith Wilson, Donna Read, Bix Beiderbecke and the Iowa Writers Workshop, should be a leader in support for arts and culture. It's one of our great industries and deserves strong state funding.

# OVERVIEW

## Public Investment Report Overview

The Iowa Cultural Coalition presents its third annual Public Investment Report, detailing public dollars for arts and culture from state and federal sources flowing through the Iowa Arts Council (*now part of Iowa Economic Development Authority*) and the State Historical Society (*now part of the Iowa Department of Administrative Services*).

The dollars come primarily from state appropriations to the IAC (*currently at about \$1.4 million or \$.46 per Iowan*) and from federal funding approved by Congress and awarded to Iowa by the National Endowment for the Arts (*\$865,270 for federal fiscal year 2022*).

As we leave the pandemic behind, funding for arts and culture is also falling behind in Iowa.

Our 2021 report saw \$11.8 million spent on arts and culture from state and federal funds, distributed through the Dept of Cultural Affairs. Our 2022 report saw \$7.83 million spent, with a reduction in federal emergency funds as the pandemic waned. 2023 saw \$4.1 million for arts and culture with funding from the state of Iowa and the National Endowment for the Arts, distributed by the Iowa Arts Council (\$3.6 million) and an additional \$500,000 from the Historical Resources Development Program (administered by the State Historical Society). These dollars continue to go to every corner of the state, funding concerts, musicians, theaters, artists, exhibitions, and museums. But many, many grant-worthy projects go unfunded because there are not enough state dollars invested in the arts and culture industry.

In the recently released Arts & Economic Prosperity 6 report from Americans for the Arts (<https://culture.iowaeda.com/impact-of-the-arts/>), they note that the arts generate \$705 million in economic activity in Iowa from nonprofit arts organizations and their audiences. This is a remarkable return on a \$4.1 million investment! Those dollars support jobs, generate taxes, and produce income for Iowans.

In addition, arts and culture help Iowa communities attract and retain talent. Creative communities do better at economic development and are more successful at keeping young people in the state. And the arts build strong, inclusive communities – rural and urban. Investing in the arts is investing in Iowa's future.

Iowa's neighboring states understand that funding for arts and culture drives economic growth. Nebraska and South Dakota spend about four times as much per capita on the arts as Iowa. The Iowa Cultural Coalition continues to support a budget for the Iowa Arts Council of \$1.00 per Iowan for the arts, which would raise us to the middle of all states in arts funding. This increase will bring new residents to our state, help rural communities flourish, and build the creative economy that the 21st century needs.
